## HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2024-2025

Cole Valley Christian Schools (CVCS) is an Early Childhood Education through 12<sup>th</sup> grade private, Christian school with just over 1,300 students on two campuses. The Secondary Campus located in Meridian, Idaho, houses grades 6-12. The four-year high school's current enrollment is approximately 401 students. Founded in 1972, the CVCS student body represents over 50 churches from throughout the Treasure Valley.
